She is the recipient of a UK Leverhulme Major Research Fellowship Award for her current project, "Sacrifice is Survival: Black Families Fighting for Freedom in the USA and Canada (1732-1936)". She is currently a Sheila Biddle Ford Foundation Fellow at the Hutchins Center for African and African American Research, Harvard University.
